

Examination and Promotion (Pre Primary - Class 5)

The promotion to the next higher class will depend on the student's progress throughout the year.

For classes I to V

- (i) The child will be evaluated throughout the year on various parameters.
- (ii) The academic year is divided into 4 evaluation tests.
- (iii) First two rounds of evaluation test will be cumulated as Ist term result and the other two rounds will be cumulated as IInd term result.
- (iv) **In case a child is absent on the scheduled Unit Test date, he/she would be marked absent and no retest will be taken.**

- Grades will be awarded on scholastic & co-scholastic areas.
- A student who fails in a class for two successive years or fails twice in three years will have to be withdrawn from the school.

Note: The Directorate of Education has removed the No Detention Policy for Grade V and VIII.
